

Classroom Behaviour

Young Women's Hub tutors plan lessons that engage students and challenge their learning. It is key that students attend these lessons with the correct attitude to learning and highest standards of behaviour.

The basics for getting this right are outlined below.

At the start of lessons students will:

- Arrive on time
- Not leave the classroom without permission from their tutor
- Place their planner, and other required equipment, on the desk
- Sit on the chair properly and face forward at all times

During lessons students will:

- Always follow the school and class rules
- Ensure they have the correct attitude to learning
- Follow work presentation standards
- Not eat
- Only drink water in with permission from the tutor

At the end of lessons students will:

- Record homework correctly in their planners
- Only pack away with permission from the tutor
- Stand behind their chair until dismissed by their tutor
